Part 3

Snow and Ice Removal from Sidewalks

§301. Owner, Occupant or Tenant of Premises to Remove Snow and Ice from Abutting Sidewalks Within 24 Hours. The owner, occupant or tenant of every property fronting upon or alongside any street in the Borough of Highspire is hereby required to remove or cause to be removed from the entire paved area of all of the sidewalks in front of or alongside such property all snow and ice thereon fallen or formed, within twenty-four (24) hours after the same shall have ceased to fall or to be formed. Provided: the owner of a property shall be responsible for conforming to the requirements of this section where such property is occupied by such owner or is vacant or unoccupied or is a multiple-unit property, occupied by more than one tenant or occupier; the tenant or occupier shall be responsible therefor where such property is a single-unit property, occupied by such tenant or occupier only. Provided further: no snow or ice removed from any sidewalk or from any private property shall be placed in any street or avenue in the Borough. (Ord. 279, 6/1/1971, §1)

§302. Authority for Borough to Remove Snow and Ice and Collect Cost, Plus 10%. In any case where any owner, tenant or occupier, as aforesaid, shall fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any of the provisions of the §301 of this Part, within the time limit therein prescribed; the Borough authorities may proceed immediately to clear all snow and/or ice from the sidewalk of such delinquent, and to collect the expenses thereof, with an additional amount of ten percent (10%) of such expenses, from such owner, occupant or tenant, as the case may be, which may be in addition to any fine or penalty imposed under §303. (Ord. 279, 6/1/1971, §2)

§303. Penalties. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part 3 shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00); and/or to imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days. Every day that a violation of this Part 3 continues shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 279, 6/1/1971, §3; as amended by Ord. 396, 6/19/1984)
