## ORDINANCE NO. 631 of 2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHSPIRE, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHSPIRE, AS IT RELATES TO "STORAGE OF UNUSED VEHICLES" PERMIT FEES

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Highspire, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:

## Section One

Chapter 13, Part 4.A., Section §405 of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Highspire is hereby amended as follows:

Permit fee; duration of permit. The vehicle storage permit shall be valid for a period of six months. Any person desiring to continue to keep a motor vehicle not regularly used for transportation stored on private property within the Borough in excess of six months shall apply to the Code Enforcement Officer of the Borough of Highspire for an extension. An extension shall be for a period not to exceed an additional six months. Only one such extension shall be permitted. The fee for a permit and permit extension shall be found in the schedule of fees which is periodically update by Highspire Borough Council Resolution.

## Section Two

Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict with the provisions hereof is hereby repealed except that nothing in this ordinance shall affect any act done or liability incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any repealed or superseded ordinance.
