**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF
HIGHSPIRE, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING EMPLOYEE
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE POLICE PENSION PLAN FOR THE 2022 PLAN YEAR.**

WHEREAS, the condition of the Police Pension Plan is such that employee contributions may be reduced or eliminated as evidenced by an actuarial study; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Highspire is able to meet the 2023 funding requirements for the Borough of Highspire Police Pension Plan; and

WHEREAS, the conditions required by Act 600 allowing for the setting of employee contributions to the Police Pension Plan have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Highspire, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, that the members of the Police Pension Plan shall contribute into the pension fund an amount equal to three percent (3%) of total compensation for the 2023 plan year, effective January 1, 2023
