ORDER

AND NOW, THIS 15th day of February 2023, upon consideration of the Motion for Enforcement of the Stipulated Order Entered July 26, 2021, filed by Lower Swatara Township and Municipal Authority of Lower Swatara Township and with the benefit of oral argument it is hereby ORDERED that the Defendants, jointly and severally, shall remit \$61,117.50 Dollars of the United States to Plaintiffs within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of this Order.

Per paragraph 2., of the Stipulated Order, Highspire was aware that the reasonable costs and Attorney’s fees associated with Lower Swatara’s review of the EDARs “may be significant”. The Court appreciates that the parties further limited the sampling of EDARs reviewed.

The Court finds the fees reasonable, although significant, they are neither subterranean, a sanction or penalty.


