PROPERTY TAXES

The Dauphin County and Highspire Borough Property Tax Notices are prepared and mailed by February 1st of each year. Property owners must pay these taxes to the Borough Tax Collector by December 31st.

The bill for the Steelton-Highspire School District is prepared and mailed by July 1st of each year. Property owners may pay this tax to the Borough Tax Collector. Payment can be made in full or in three (3) installments.

CLEAN WATER IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

Polluted stormwater runoff causes harmful effects on drinking water supplies, recreation, fish and wildlife, and the local economy. Here are some things you can do to prevent stormwater runoff pollution and keep our water clean:



- Use lawn care products such as fertilizer, herbicides and pesticides sparingly and carefully follow label directions.
- Never dump anything down storm drains or in streams.
- Vegetate bare spots in your yard and compost your yard waste.
- Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces to vegetated areas.

- Use a car wash that recycles its water.
- Maintain your vehicle to prevent leaks.
- Properly dispose of pet waste.
- Maintain septic systems in proper working order.

STORAGE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

A vehicle is considered abandoned even if it is parked on your property when the vehicle registration and/or inspection has expired and/or if the vehicle is inoperable or damaged; however, an



owner may obtain a permit to store the vehicle for six (6) months from the Code & Zoning Office for a fee of \$45.00.
